ADVANCING CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT

Y programs are committed to executing experiences rich in SEL for this reason; youth do better when they have supportive adults nurturing their potential. As academic demands evolve within our education system, the Y will continue to prioritize education, SEL and safety for the children in our care. In 2022, the Y will:

- Provide affordable school aged childcare to 30 Yuma families through scholarships which allow children to grow and learn life skills in a safe after school environment

SUPPORTING SENIORS

Seniors comprise 18% of the Arizona population and have experienced increased isolation due to the pandemic. Many seniors in the community lack the resources to engage virtually. As they remain cautious against COVID-19, the Y is passionate about supporting this population. We work to reduce depression and fear through outreach programs and safe social gatherings. Help the Y continue our senior outreach program to connect with those who need a supportive friend or voice during this uncertain time.

In 2022, the Y will:

- Promote mental and physical wellness for 100 Yuma seniors through programs that encourage fellowship and building healthy habits.

DEVELOPING COMMUNITY LEADERS

By 2030, the majority of the U.S. population will be young adults between 18 and 35 years of age. As the world grows in complexity and teens become more isolated, providing programs that build a sense of belonging and welcome young people to develop their self-identity is increasingly important.
