## WHAT TO EXPECT:

Each day, your child should bring sunscreen and a water bottle. Be sure to label all items. Every camp includes traditional activities such as weekly themed games, field trips, environmental education, crafts, songs, skits, and water activities including swimming. Your child should wear a camp t-shirt on all field trips. You can purchase shirts at our Welcome Center desk. We provide an afternoon snack - snack calendars will be posted weekly. Crane Schools Nutrition Program will provide Breakfast and Lunch.

## REGISTRATION & PAYMENT INFORMATION:

All campers must be registered for each week of camp with full payment by the time they are dropped off at the start of each week. The registration packet includes: YMCA registration form, Arizona Department of Health Services Emergency, Information and Immunization card, Best of Care form, and a copy of immunization records.
